Reading Together – launching this programme for parents.....it will continue in 2013.




The collaboration with St Teressa's Plimmerton.....our students teaching their students Cook Island song and dance....

Positive contacts made with families – to share and celebrate their child's contribution to our school.





It's hard to imagine how the music room programme could have gone any better than this year. I am a lucky man indeed to have had the privilege of working with a plethora of talented students.


I will miss the amazing year 8's but can already see the year 7's stepping into their shoes.





FACTS ABOUT OUR CULTURE!


- 1. Islam means peace through the submission to GOD.






